★ FMCSA Data

- FMCSA is focusing outreach efforts to better inform safety stakeholders about information FMCSA makes available to the public.
- FMCSA uses this information to analyze a motor carrier's current safety performance and determine whether investigation or intervention is necessary.





Three primary sources of FMCSA data

- 1. Safety and Fitness Electronic Records (SAFER)
- 2. Licensing & Insurance (L&I)
- 3. Safety Measurement System (SMS)







What does SAFER provide?

- Carrier census information
- Inspection out-of-service (OOS) rates compared to national averages over the last 24 months
- Carrier crashes over the last 24 months
- Carrier safety fitness rating (if one exists)
 - Satisfactory, Conditional, Unsatisfactory
- Flag if carrier is prohibited from operating

- Flag if carrier is under an FMCSA order prohibiting operations





BASICs as of December 2012



★ BASIC Thresholds

- Were determined based on analysis and effectiveness studies
- Using the improved SMS, the goal is to identify carriers with both:
 - Crash rate higher than the population average; and
 - Known on-road compliance issues

BASIC	General	HM	Passenger
Unsafe Driving, Hours-of-Service (HOS) Compliance, Crash Indicator	65%	60%	50%
Driver Fitness, Vehicle Maintenance, Controlled Substances/Alcohol	80%	75%	65%
Hazardous Materials (HM) Compliance	80%	80%	80%







- Carrier census information
- Analysis of carrier on-road performance and investigation results based on the most recent 24 months in BASICs
- Overall BASIC status (status above threshold may prioritize the carrier for intervention)
- Flag if carrier is under an FMCSA order prohibiting operations
- Driver and Vehicle Inspection OOS rates
- Links to detailed individual inspection results and trend data
- Links to SAFER and L&I for current safety rating and authority/insurance status

The data in the Safety Measurement System (SMS) is performance data used by the Agency and Enforcement Community. A \(\Delta\) symbol, based on the data, indicates that FMCSA may prioritize a motor carrier for a safety intervention.

The \(\begin{align*} \text{ Symbol is not intended to imply any federal safety rating of the carrier pursuant to 49 USC 31144. Readers should not draw conclusions about a carrier's overall safety condition simply based on the data displayed in this system. Unless a motor carrier in the SMS has received an UNSATISFACTORY safety rating pursuant to 49 CFR Part 385, or has otherwise been ordered to discontinue operations by the FMCSA, it is authorized to operate on the nation's roadways.











Relevant Inspections vs Inspections with Violations














